## “Pray First, Walk Together and Transform Lives for Christ”

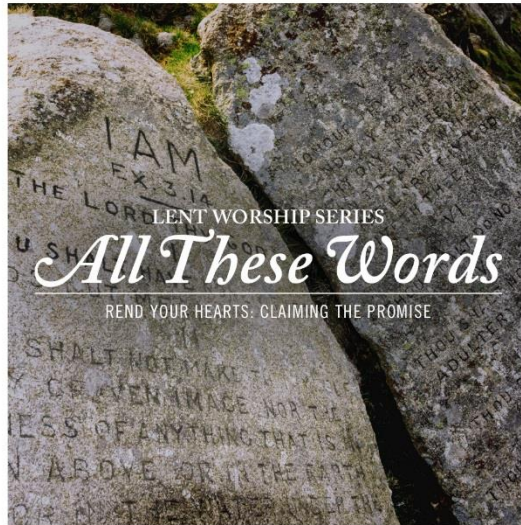
We are well into the season of Lent. Reflecting on the areas of our lives which need our attention, need revision, or resourcing, that we may continue to grow in our relationship with God and with others.

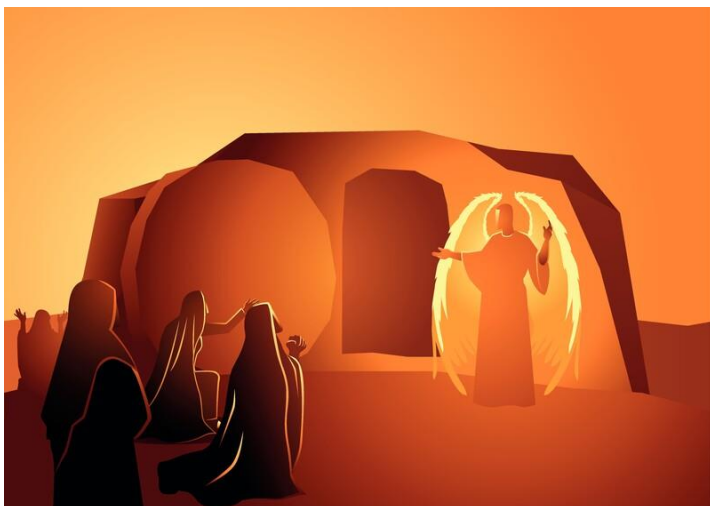

## **FINANCE**

We started 2021 with a positive balance of \$13,520.32 in our Current Expense account and as of January 31, 2021 we have a positive balance of \$10,146.24, however, we have not paid our shared ministries for January totaling \$2,117.00. Our year to date income has totaled \$9,597.15 and our year to date expenses have totaled \$12,971.23. Our income has been \$3,374.08 lower than our expenses.

## **TRUSTEES NEWS**

In January of this year we did some plumbing work over at the parsonage. We replaced all of the sewer lines inside of the basement with a material donation from Flint Bros. Hardware and with the work of some of our members. The sewer line from the basement was replaced by Pynn Plumbing for \$4,500, they donated \$1,000 bringing the bill to the church down to \$3,500. This project was financed from the capital improvement fund. The pledges for 2021 for this fund totaled \$3,490, this already puts us at a deficit for 2021. As a group we decided that it would be a good idea to have a fundraiser to help replenish some of the money we have spent from this fund. On February 20<sup>th</sup> we had a drive thru breakfast and were able to make a profit of \$581.03 Thanks to everyone that supported this either through working, buying a breakfast or helping to pass the word along. With the success of this breakfast we have decided to have another breakfast on March 20, 2021 from 8-10 AM. Menu will be eggs, sausage links, potatoes, sweet roll and juice for \$8.
